Re: White River Amphitheater Parking & Snow Day Make-up

Dear Parents/Guardians of White River Seniors:

Graduation is quickly approaching, and I would like to update you on an item that we recently became aware of concerning our graduation ceremony on the evening of Thursday, June 7th. It is nothing major, but I do want to provide you with this information early so that you will be prepared, and can inform additional family and friends who are planning to attend graduation.

Enclosed you will find a detailed map showing the entire Amphitheater venue, and the various parking areas. In past years, the A Lot has been available for parking; however, this year the A Lot will be closed due to another event that the Amphitheater has scheduled. Therefore, all parking will be in the B, C & D Lots, **with the paved portion of the C Lot reserved for handicapped parking.** The entrance for our handicapped guests will be Gate 9. All others will enter through the Main Entrance Gate. Please be aware that due to the heightened security that is being enforced in many public facilities, the White River Amphitheater has now installed metal detectors, and will be enforcing their policies as if you were attending any other event being hosted by the Amphitheater. This includes bag searches and the use of wands to detect items prohibited by the Amphitheater. The following items are prohibited, and will be confiscated:

- Weapons of any kind
- Alcohol
- Illegal drugs/substances
- Glass containers
- Cans/compressed air
- Hard sided/large coolers
- Large or oversized bags/back packs, such as luggage, duffel bags, or industrial camping sized back packs
- Laser pointers
- Animals (exception being service animals)
- Fireworks

Again, these are policies and procedures of White River Amphitheater/Live Nation, and will be strictly enforced. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact our office.

Also, due to the cancellation of school for the February 22nd snow day, Seniors must make-up the missed school day on a Saturday. Therefore, Saturday, May 12th has been scheduled for the make-up day between the hours of 8:00 – 11:00 am. This day is therefore considered a regular school day, and attendance will be taken. Any Senior not attending will be marked absent, and unless the student has a legitimate excuse, it will be an unexcused absence.

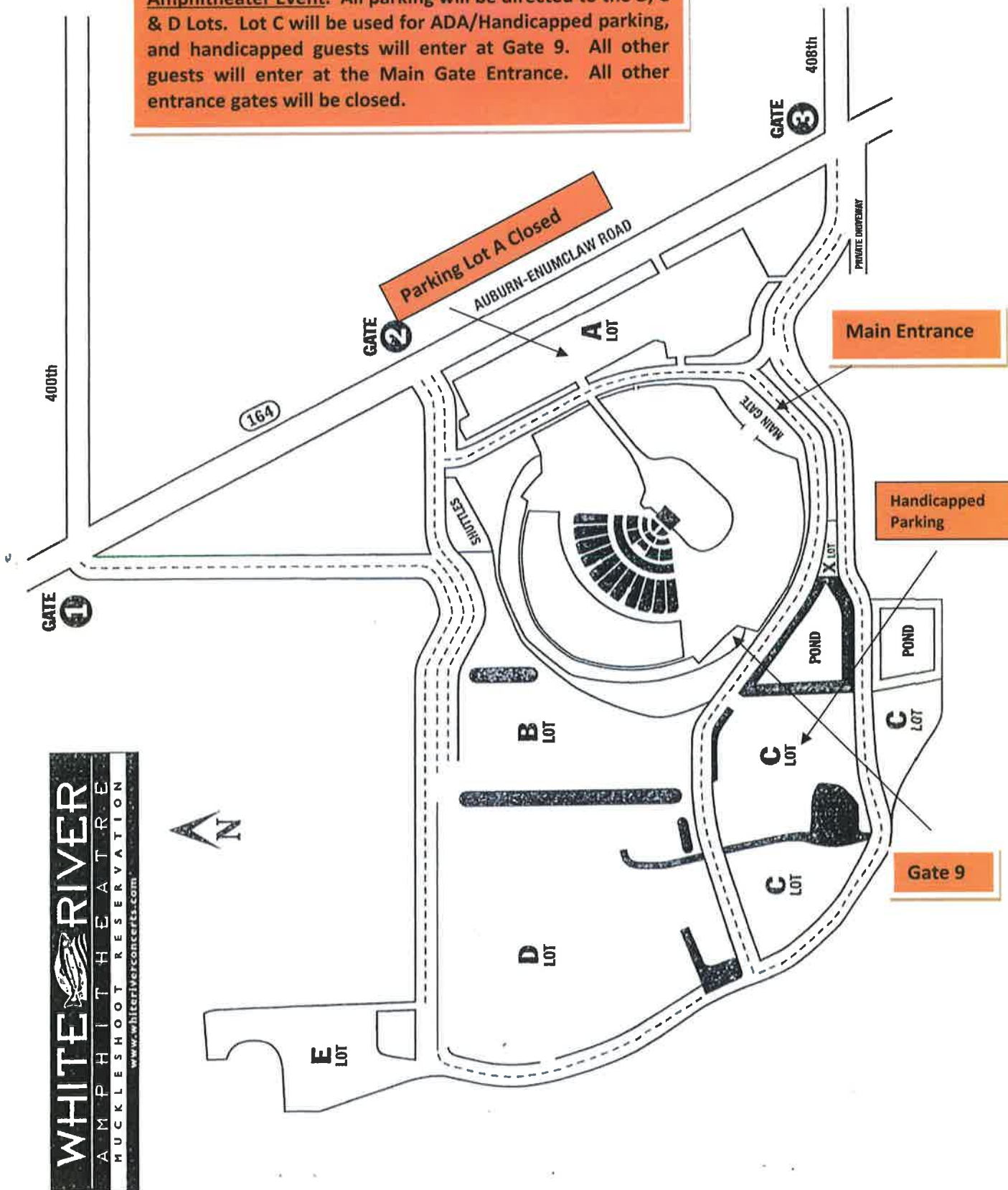
